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### Promoters Conditions

#### 1) Introduction

- a) The competition will be held under Swim England Rules and Technical Regulations. The Meet is a Level 3 Short Course (25m) licensed meet. Licence no. **3NW192988**.
- b) It will be held at Macclesfield Leisure Centre on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> and Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2019.
- c) Proposed session timings are shown in the Meet Information, these will be confirmed once entries have closed.

#### 2) Eligibility

- a) The Meet shall be open to all eligible swimmers who are members of Clubs affiliated to the Swim England, Swim Wales or Swim Scotland. Entries may also be considered by invitation to foreign competitors who are members of a country affiliated to FINA.
- b) The swimmers age for competition shall be that as at the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019.
- c) Entrants must have achieved a time no faster than the published time for each event entered, that time to have been achieved in the last 12 months preceding the last date of the competition.
- d) Improved times following entry can be accepted on the Swimming Events website up to the close of withdrawals.

#### 3) Events

- a) All events will be held on a Heat Declared Winner (HDW) basis. Heats will be arranged by submitted entry times and all heats will be spearheaded
- b) All 50's, 100's and 200's may be swum, given the entry criteria is met.

#### 4) Entries

- a) **Entry fees shall be tiered, with £5 per event if entered before 8<sup>th</sup> September 2019 (Early Bird Rate), £6 standard entry per event up to the closing date of 8<sup>th</sup> December 2019 and £12 per event after this time up to the start of the competition. Entries may be accepted up to the close of withdrawals (this is subject to the meet not being full). Any entries received after the Midnight on the 8<sup>th</sup> December 2019 may not be in the printed programme and may not be accepted if the meet is over subscribed. If the meet is oversubscribed at any time, the entries will be closed, and accepted entries will subsequently published. The meet will be on a first come first served basis.**
- b) Paper entries are NOT ACCEPTED.
- c) Entry times must be:

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- i) 25m times, or
- ii) 50m times converted to 25m times.
- d) All converted times must use the ASA Equivalent Performance Tables (use of the ASA Tables section on <http://www.pullbuoy.co.uk/times/> is permissible).
- e) **Refunds will not be given for incorrect entries** which result in rejection.
- f) The Competition Secretary reserves the right to restrict entries in the interests of safety, time constraints and to ensure the smooth running of the competition. Where this process is invoked the swimmers with the fastest submitted times in each age group shall take precedence. Events chosen for restriction will be at the discretion of the Promoter.
- g) Closing date for entries is the day before the start of competition. Subject to the meet not being full.
- h) Submission of entries
  - i) Submission of entries will be submitted via the <https://swimming.events> application.
  - ii) Any queries on the submission of entries should be directed to [galas@swimsatellite.co.uk](mailto:galas@swimsatellite.co.uk).
- i) Accepted entries will be emailed to the email address used to register on Swimming Events and will be published on the Swimming Events website.
- j) Poolside entries may be accepted at the late pricing rate of £12 per race. This will be up to the close of withdrawals.
- k) Clubs will be expected to provide at least 1 official for every 10 swimmers entered.

### 5) Disability competitors

- a) The general conditions for the Meet shall apply to disability competitors except where varied by any of the following conditions.
- b) All competitors must:
  - i) Have an authorised British Swimming, WPS or INAS-FID Classification which is held on by British Swimming or WPS classification database OR a valid Certificate of Swimming Disability issued by Swim England, at the time of entry
  - ii) A Certificate of Swimming Disability must be presented to the Referee before the start of the race in which the competitor is entered. Failure to do so will leave the competitor liable for disqualification for non-compliance with stroke rules.
- c) Qualifying times for disability competitors are not required. However, entry times shall be submitted for the purpose of seeding the heats.
- d) Classified swimmers must state their classification codes on their entry
- e) Personal Care Attendants/Coaches:

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- i) Personal care attendants will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes: S1, S2, S3, S4, S5 and S11.
- ii) All coaches, chaperones and personal care attendants (no charge for personal care assistant poolside pass) must conform to the Swim England child protection procedures.
- f) The competition format will be based on disability inclusion within the able-bodied programme, i.e. there will be no separate events for swimmers with disabilities.
- g) All swimmers will be seeded in the heats according to their entry times.
- h) Disability competitors will be included within the results for their age group.

### 6) Awards

- a) The top boy and top girl cash prizes
  - i) Top boy and top girl cash awards will be based on the best 7 finish results from each swimmer in the following age groups: 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years and 16 years/over.
  - ii) The cash prize will be £25 for the top boy and girl in each age group. In the event of a draw, the prize money will be split equally.
  - iii) Points will be allocated on the following basis: 1<sup>st</sup> = 8 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 7 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 6 points, 4<sup>th</sup> = 5 points, 5<sup>th</sup> = 4 points, 6<sup>th</sup> = 3 points, 7<sup>th</sup> = 2 points and 8<sup>th</sup> = 1 point. Any prizes not claimed at the close of the competition will be sent to the relevant clubs.
- b) Medals
  - i) Medals will be awarded to the top 3 in each event of the following age groups: 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years and 16 years/over.
- c) Disability Awards
  - i) Medals shall be awarded on a multi-class basis to the first 3 swimmers in each event based upon British Disability Point scores.
  - ii) If there are less than four disability competitors in any one event, then a minus one rule shall apply.
  - iii) If there is only one disability competitor in an event, then a medal shall be presented if the swimmer betters their entry time.
- d) Spot prizes
  - i) Spot prizes will be awarded to the winners of randomly pre-selected heats.

### 7) Withdrawals

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- a) Notification may be completed via the Swimming Events application in your profile. This can be done no later than midnight on the 20<sup>th</sup> December 2019 for the 1<sup>st</sup> day of competition. Any withdrawals for the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of competition must be communicated before midnight on the 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019.
- b) It is strongly recommended that all withdrawals are done through the Swimming Events Application.
- c) Swimmers who fail to withdraw in the prescribed manner shall be removed from the remainder of their events entered at the competition.
- d) Refunds will be provided in only exceptional circumstances such as a medical condition. These requests will be dealt with on a case by case basis and should be emailed to [galas@swimsatellite.co.uk](mailto:galas@swimsatellite.co.uk). NOT Swimming Events.

### 8) Coaches/Team Managers

- a) Passes will be free\* for bona-fide Coaches and Team Managers. This will include a Programme and Heat Start Lists. \*Free passes will be allocated as 1 pass per 10 swimmers. Additional passes will be £15 each to cover all sessions.
- b) Poolside passes/wristband must be worn at all times, failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the pool deck.
- c) Poolside passes will only be issued to coaches and team managers with a current DBS check and Swim England registration number. All details should be sent to [galas@swimsatellite.co.uk](mailto:galas@swimsatellite.co.uk).

### 9) Promoters Rights

- a) The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
- b) The order of events may be changed at the discretion of the promoters. However, this will only be done if necessary and entrants will be notified at the earliest opportunity.
- c) Anything not covered in the above - or not printed in other meet information will be at the discretion of the promoters.
